## Highlights from the Year

- Creation and implementation of library Moodle page. Listed under Organizations, the site features a news forum, calendar, resources, instructional guides and other features.
- Creation of an extensive inventory database including all computer and related equipment in the library.
- Duane Huval and Jason Johnson developed an acquisitions ordering database using MS Access. This replaces the PC File database and has many different features, including reports by department, remaining funds, average vendor savings,

monograph orders for the fiscal year and requisition totals. It provides a user-friendly data input form for ordering books.

- Duane Huval created a Moodle page under Organizations for the STEP Lab workers. It is working well to facilitate staff communication.
- An interactive map of Dupre Library first floor was developed. An easy-to-use Flash application displays the different locations and provides details about the different services. Lance Chance, BI/Distance Learning Librarian, created the design. - The Friends, Tech and STEP web sites were given temporary custody to Sherry Curry.
- A new look for library web site was launched. It has given a more user-friendly interface. Navigating from the home page is now easier than ever. The home page offers quick access to the iLink online catalog, the new interactive Ask Reference service, and other library services. Conversion is ongoing.
- A Self-Checkout system for books is now in operation. It has been a success and is an asset to the library. The Systems Department maintains it.

## Grants

- Duane Huval was awarded a STEP Grant of \$130,930 to provide for computer replacement, maintenance and staff funding for the STEP Lab.
