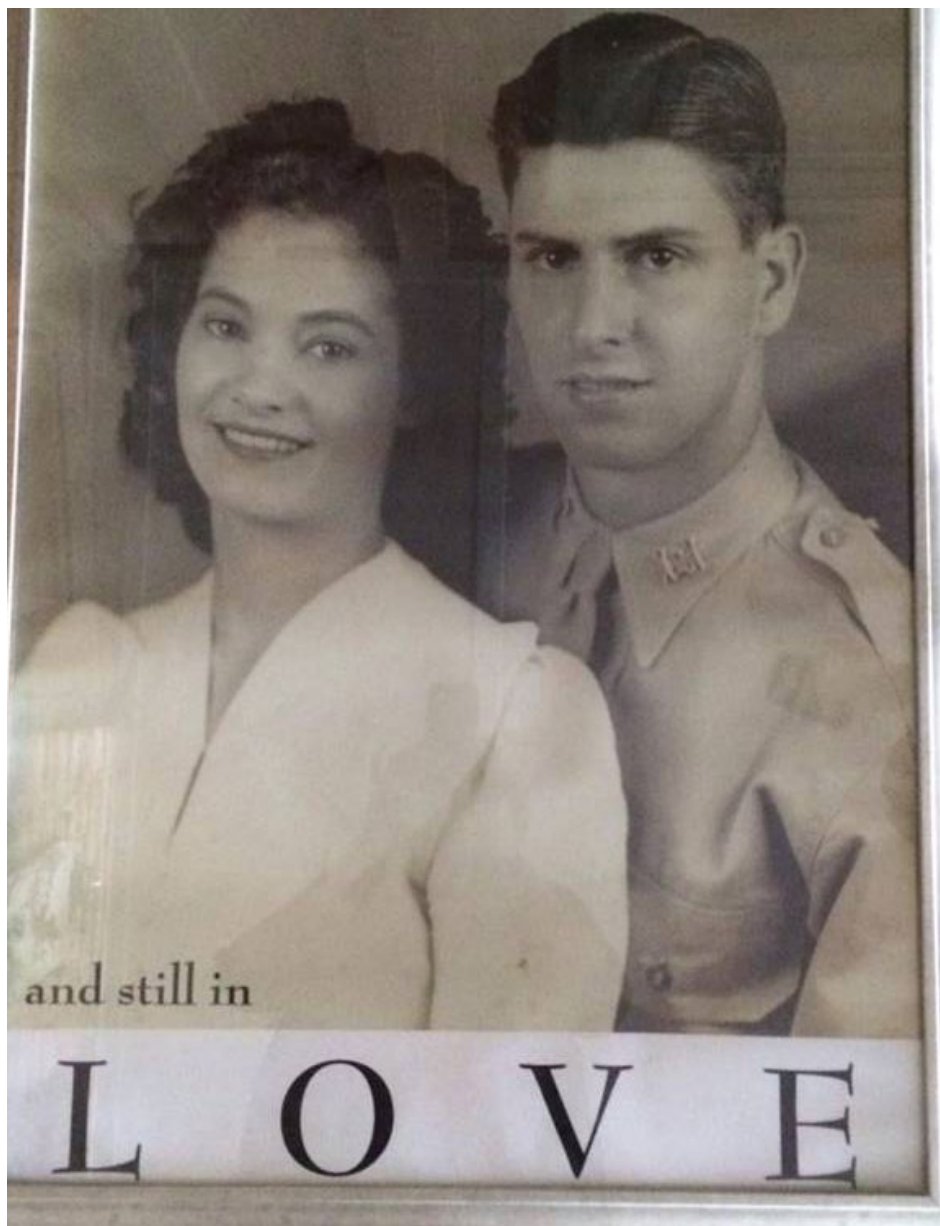

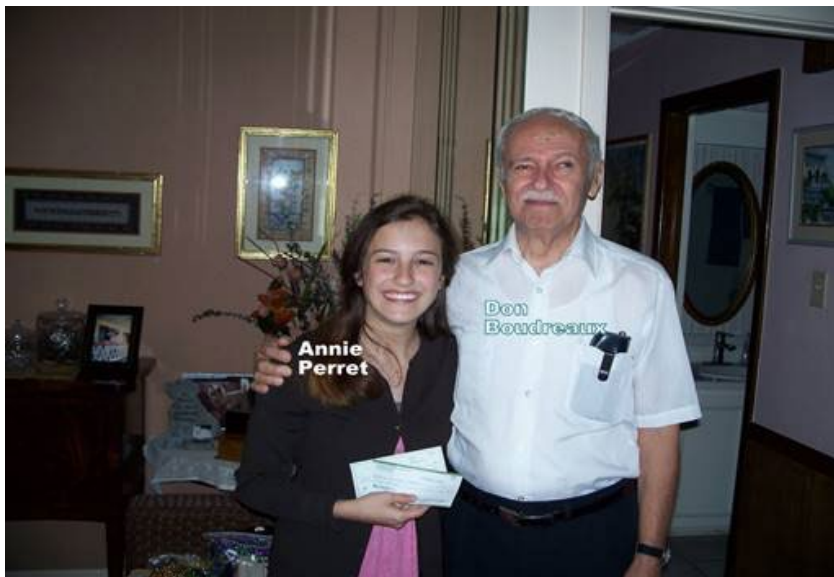

1950 Henry High Class Reunion honors three former teachers

Saturday afternoon was the 50th class reunion for the 1965 graduating class of Henry High School. What made this reunion special was not the graduates who attended but the former teachers who were there.

The reunion was held at Warren Perrin's parents' old home, which is less than a mile from the old Henry High School, which is no longer standing. Perrin, the class president, orchestrated the reunion and also invited three teachers who taught the students either in elementary school or high school.

In attendance were teachers Edna Mae Landry, a second grade teacher, Billie Wayne Broussard, an English teacher and former librarian, and Johnny Picard, a former ag teacher.

They were greeted by nine out of 13 graduates.

Broussard, who is 80, was also given a special honor by being inducted into the Living Legends in Erath. She was inducted because of her total years in education in Vermilion Parish. She retired in 1990.

Perrin presented her with the honor, which she was not expecting. Her family was on hand to witness her induction.

"She came to Henry High School to help pre-



pare to teaching us English and she
"Without Mrs. Broussard I would still
be in high school. Thank you."

"We learned a little bit of English
and we became friends," said Broussard.
"Many are still my friends. I really enjoyed
teaching at Henry. I enjoyed the people.
Thank you all very much. You all have
given me a distinct honor."

Edna Mae Landry only taught at Henry
High School for one year - her first year
in education. It was a second grade class.

Landry, who is from Maurice, said she
is not sure why she did not stay longer at
Henry. After leaving Henry High School

a school in Abbeville before ending up at
Maurice High School, the school she grad-
uated from.

"I kept getting closer and closer to Mau-
rice," said Landry, who is now 84 years
old. She retired from teaching in 1984.

Legendary coach Johnny Picard began
his coaching career at Henry High School.
It was his first coaching job, as well as
teaching job. His basketball team won
only two games his final year at Henry
School.

He became the Maurice High School

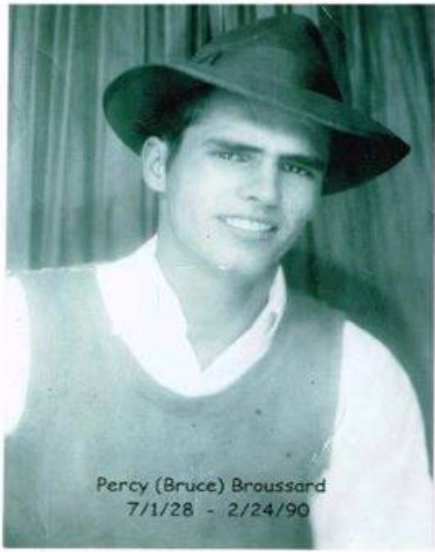
he won two basketball state titles and a
handful of track state titles.

Picard, who graduated from Maurice
High in 1955, admitted going from the re-
lax atmosphere of Henry to a school where
winning was expected.

"Maurice had a good feeder program
and they had good freshmen coming up, so
I did not mind coming," said Picard. "You
were taking a chance. I told Warren (Per-
rin) when I was at Henry, we would cheer
on the way to a game and we would cheer

BROUSSARD

In Broussard, Louisiana, stands a monument dedicated to a man who spent most of his life two thousand miles north in Acadie. The British of his day called him an outlaw, murderer and pirate. The French called him a patriot, founder of New Acadia. One thing neither his friends nor his enemies called him was his baptized name, Joseph Brossard. They called him "Beausoleil".

Joseph's brother Claude settled in Port Royal. After the deportation, Claude's sons Charles and Pierre settled in Pomquet (1764 and 1792) and their descendants remain here to this day.

This plaque, commemorating the Broussard Heritage, was erected by La Famille Broussard Société, Nouvelle- Écosse, (Acadie) through a donation by the Famille Beausoleil Association, Broussard, Louisiana. 08/12/2004.

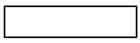

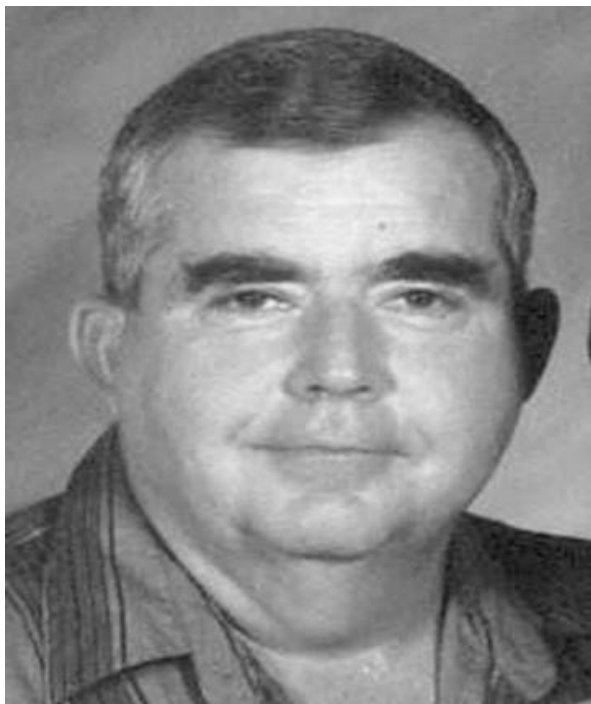

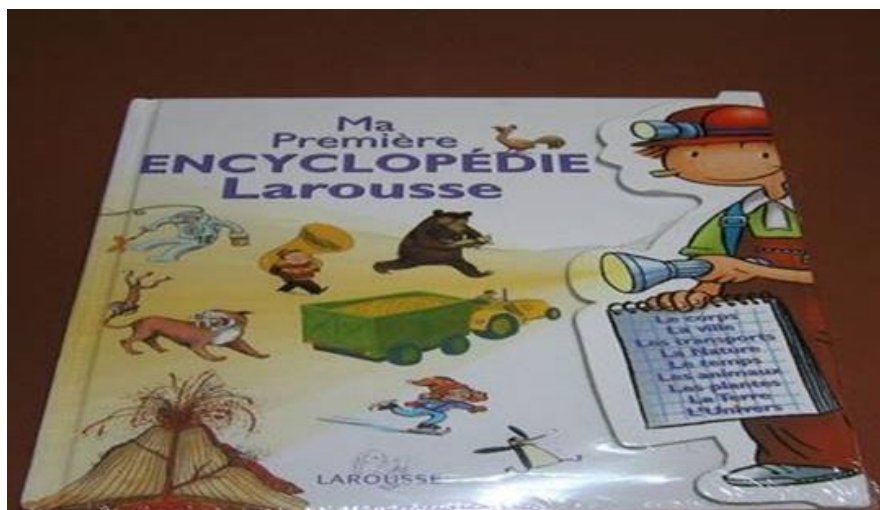

MADAWASKA, Maine - Costumed walkers, with noisemakers, took part in a downtown "Grand Tintamarre" on Friday evening.

The annual Acadian Festival noise parade, with a designated route of nearly a half-mile, coincided this year with Congrès mondial acadien 2014 / 2014 World Acadian Congress. Its purpose was to celebrate National Acadian Day on Aug. 15.

Wearing T-shirts with family names, colorful costumes, Grosses Têtes and stilts, participants left the St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church parking lot at 5:55 p.m. and proceeded down 11th Avenue to Main Street, then east and up 5th Avenue to the Multi-Purpose Building. 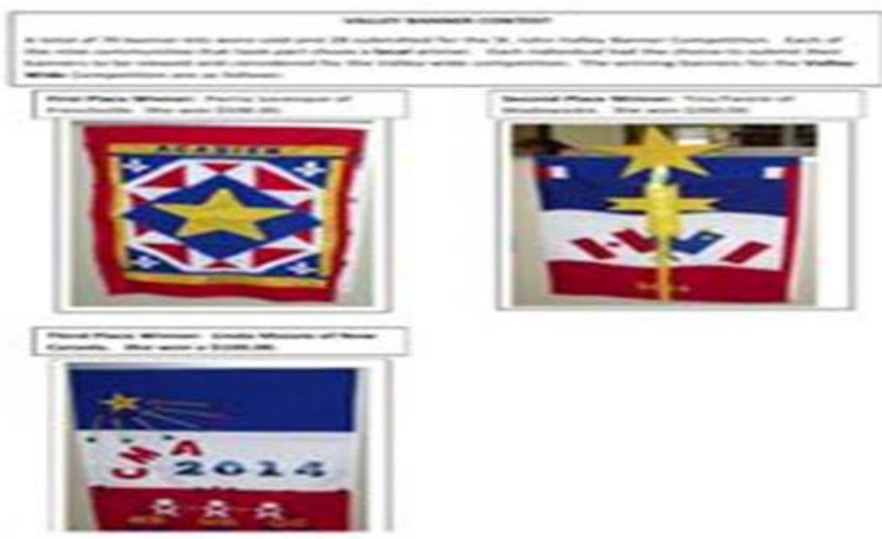

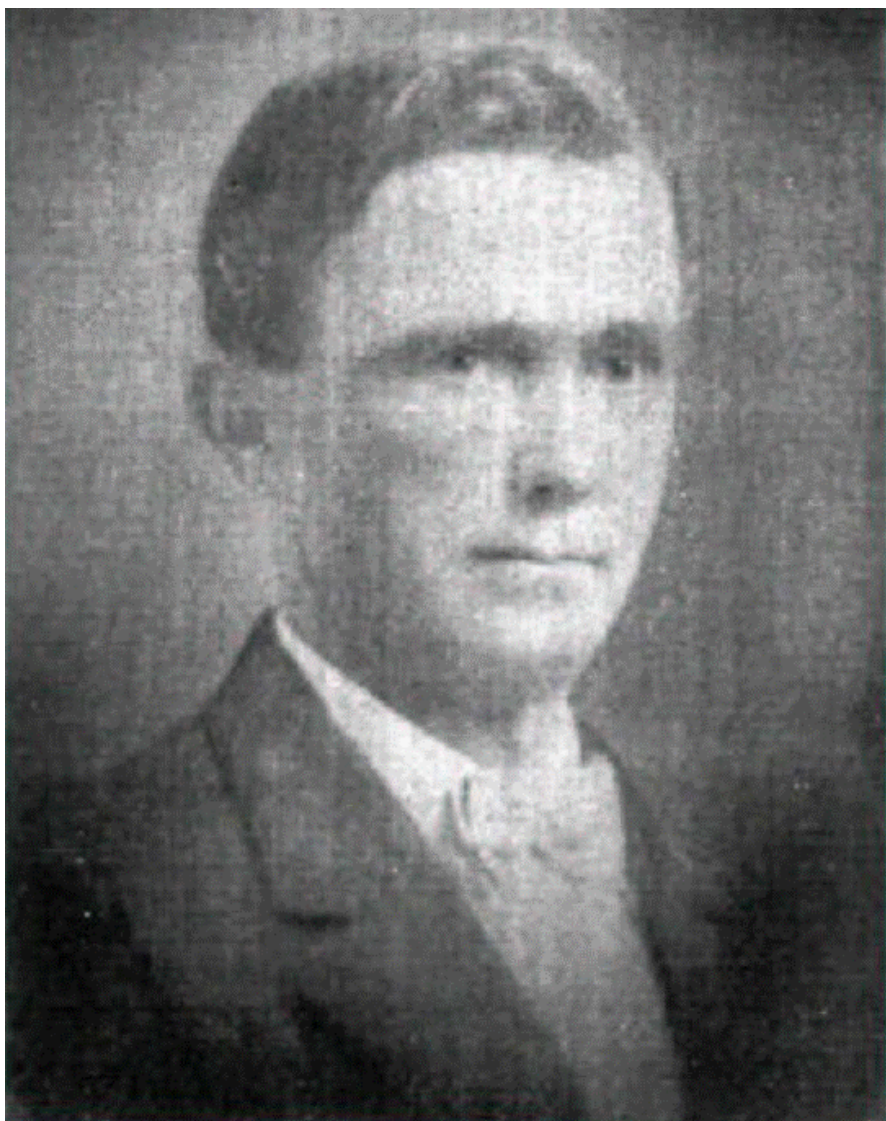

Ada Hebert Broussard lost her husband, Camille, during the height of the Depression, leaving her with 10 surviving children. They were Edward, Doris (Dartez), Lastie, Gladys (Trahan), Wallace, Alice (Schroder), John, Willie, Walter and Faye (Prejean).

From 1952 until 1962, the family met in Ada Broussard's small two bedroom home located on the main street in Maurice, across the street from the church. When the dwelling became too small to

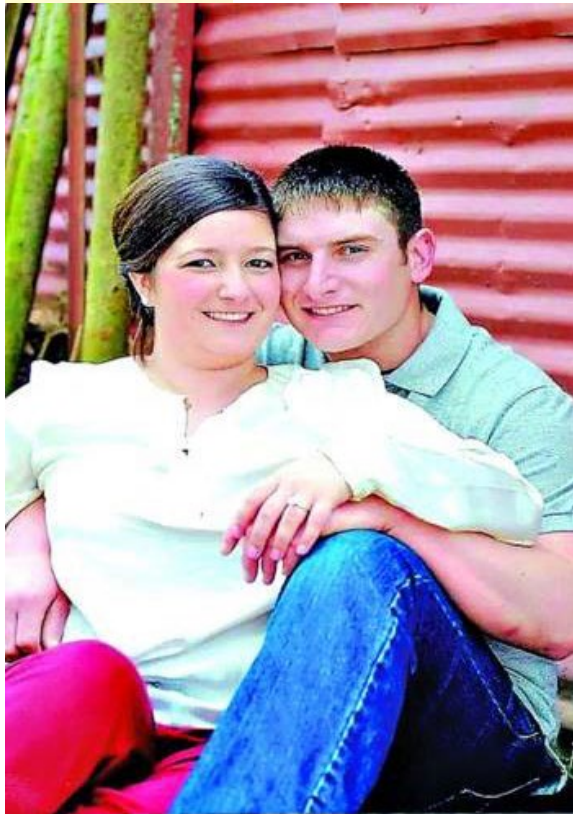

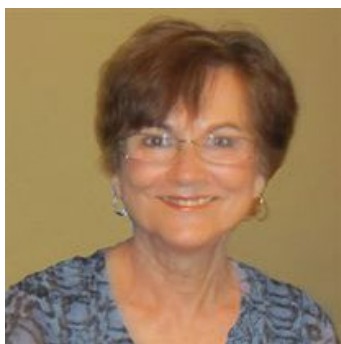

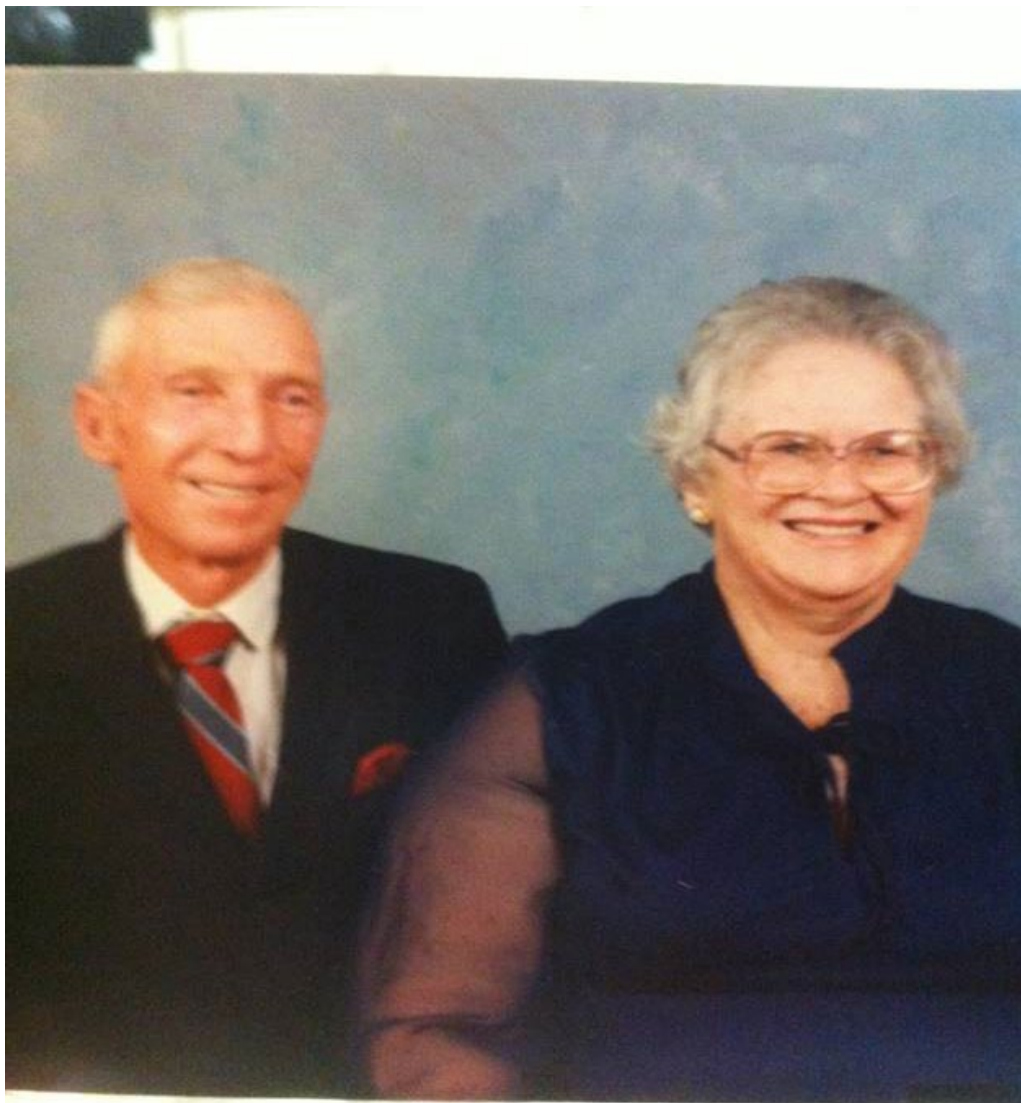
