- Added 1,060 new physical items to U.S. Government Information.

## **OUTREACH**

We reached over 1,800 prospective students and their family members at events. We hosted 17 events with over 900 participants.

#### **STUDY SPACES**

Our individual and group study rooms were checked out 8,700 times That's a 58% increase from last year.

#### **EXHIBITS**

We hosted 13 exhibits in our Grand Hall, including "Americans and the Holocaust," a traveling exhibition organized by the American Library Association and the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum.

#### **EMPLOYMENT**

We provided employment to over 40 students and awarded over \$117,000 of federal work study, scholarship and grant funds, including three graduate assistantships.

# **NEW SERVICES**

The faculty and staff at Edith Garland Dupré Library are always innovating. This year, we introduced several major services that expand access to educational and research materials and much more.

Rapid ILL offers free access to journal articles and book chapters with 24-hour turnaround times.

Institutional Repository hosts and provides open access to UL Lafayette student and faculty research.

Map to Black Studies Collection includes over 600 titles in support of UL Lafayette's Black Studies minor.

Library of Things provides students free access to all manner of items: design supplies, board games and baking pans, and it continues to grow!
